Yoma - Perek 4:2-3



Mishna 2: The Kohen Gadol tied red wool between the horns of the Azazel goat and faced it east toward the gate, and tied red wool around the neck of the 'LaHashem' goat to be sacrificed...

Mishna 2-3: He then returns to his Chatas-ox, does semicha by leaning on it, says a vidui confession, and makes the initial cut in its slaughter. He receives the shechita blood in a bowl, which is constantly stirred by another Kohen standing on the "4th row of paving stones" by the entrance to the Heichal.

Mishna 3: The Kohen Gadol took a golden shovel up the ramp to the Outer Alter, scooped up some of the glowing coals, and then took it back down the ramp. He brought the shovel to the fourth row of paving stones next to the stirring Kohen, and put it down temporarily.
